

BAY-RAMA PARADE
RULES AND REGULATIONS/RESTRICTIONS

1. A signed waiver of liabilities must accompany all applications. See attached.
2. All parade participants must show respect for all ages, sexes, sexual orientations, races, creeds and cultures of both the Anchor Bay Community as well as others attending.
3. The consumption or possession of alcoholic or illegal substances is forbidden by any one anywhere throughout the parade or any float or vehicle or on the person of any participant.
4. The Bay-Rama Festival or its Parade Committee reserves the rights to bar or remove from the parade any entry which refuses to follow all rules, regulations, restrictions or instructions from parade officials and/or police.
5. All sound systems, bands on floats etc have to be authorized by parade committee.
6. Tossing of items toward the spectators is strictly prohibited No flowers, candy, trinkets, leaflets, coupons or samples of any kind are to be tossed out to the spectators. They can be handed out only. Parade committee must approve all items handed out.
- 7. Please maintain distance of 25 feet (2 car lengths) from the unit in front of you.** Spacing between each unit will be enforced by parade officials, units are required to close the gap between itself and the preceding units when directed by parade officials. If you cannot keep pace with the units ahead of you, your unit will be asked to leave the parade route.
- 8.** A reviewing stand will be located on the right side of the street in the intersection at Washington and Green Street This is where the Judges will be viewing and judging your unit... DO NOT STOP....
- 9.** All musical units please play as much as possible. The spectators love to hear your music.
- 10.**All units will exit the parade route just before Green Street and County Line Road unless instructed otherwise by parade officials or police.
- 11.**The **maximum number of people permitted in the unit is 35** with the exception of bands and military units.
- 12. Equestrian units must provide their own sanitation in the form of a pooper-scooper or by diaper and will marshal with the unit.** This will be enforced.
- 13.**Please remember this is a family event proper and appropriate attire and behavior is required. The Parade Committee will pull out any unit that does not keep the theme or their behavior within a family guideline. Entries are not allowed to make statements through their advertising that is not deemed family oriented. Examples of this would be but are not limited to race, creed, pro-life, pro-choice and other sensitive issues. The Parade Committee will be instructed to remove you from the parade.
